

What sets our program apart in Europe is that it offers over 60 hours of in-flight training in a multiengine aircraft equipped with a modern glass cockpit. GreyBird has bases in three countries: **Denmark**, Sweden, and Spain, and is expanding to Finland, Ireland and France in 2025. THE BEST FUTURE PILOTS

At GreyBird, we set the standard in European aviation training with our modern Tecnam aircraft. Our programs offer more advanced and comprehensive flight training compared to others in the industry, all while maintaining a competitive price point. A GreyBird graduate completes their training with an impressive 205 flight hours, including 137 hours in state-of-the-art Tecnam planes.

This exceptional hands-on experience ensures you receive the highest quality education, equipping you with the skills and confidence needed for a successful career as a pilot.

In the final phase of your training, you'll spend 40 hours in an FNPT II MCC Airbus A320 simulator, completing the Airline Pilot Standard Multi-Crew Cooperation (APS MCC) course.

When you graduate from GreyBird, you will have completed 62 hours of flight time in a real multiengine airplane, complemented by 25 hours in our procedure simulator—a precise replica of the aircraft. As you compare flight academies, pay close attention to the amount of real multi-engine flight time offered. At many schools, a significant portion of training is conducted in simulators that differ from the actual aircraft, or worse, in single-engine planes for IFR training. While these methods may be cost-effective, they often result in negative training and lack the comprehensive value of true multiengine experience.

Instead of paying for all or even most of your flying lessons upfront, you will only need to cover an entrance fee and make payments at the start of each of the four modules. HOW TO GET STARTED

At GreyBird, we encourage you to arrange a personal meeting with us. A member of our recruitment team will be present to ensure you receive the information you need. Following the meeting, we'll give you a tour of our facilities, and most importantly, you'll have the opportunity to ask all your questions in a one-on-one setting tailored to you.

THE REQUIREMENTS

Many people have an incorrect perception of what it takes to become a commercial pilot. Perhaps you know some of the requirements from the air force, or you may have heard urban legends. The requirements for flying airliners are far from the same as the requirements in the military.

For instance, it is OK to wear glasses or contact lenses; there are no special requirements to your height; and a broken leg or any other broken bones will not be a hindrance. Your physical and mental health must be good, which is the case for most young people. You do not need to have top grades from school, and there are no requirements for specific subjects. In fact, you do not need a high school diploma at all. You must have passed what corresponds to the ninth-grade final exams of the primary and lower secondary school, and you must be at least 18 years old when you graduate. To enroll at GreyBird, you also need to pass an admission test and produce a certificate of clean criminal record.

FREE ADMISSION TEST

The admission test at GreyBird consists of an interview, written math test, an English test, a personality test and a test of logical thinking. The admission test at GreyBird Pilot Academy is free. The last step before you can start your education is a realistic financial plan. We offer help and guidance if you need to take a loan from the bank. In addition, we have payment plans and budgets which are a good place to start when you need to negotiate with the bank.

THE MEDICAL CHECK-UP



CLASS 1 MEDICAL

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When you are ready to apply for enrollment at GreyBird, you need to visit an **Aeromedical Center (AMC)** to get your Class 1 Medical which is the medical certificate that is required to become a commercial pilot.

It is OK to wear glasses or contact lenses, and there are no special requirements to your height. We have a list of relevant AMCs and can provide information on how fast you are likely to get an appointment as well as the cost at the given AMC.

OUR FLEET

We use **Tecnam airplanes** with a new and unique design. We have bought most of our aircraft directly from the factory, and we have flown them to our bases from Naples ourselves. The trip from Naples takes approx. 15 hours if the aircraft is heading for Denmark. Europe is small when you've got wings. We use two types of airplanes when educating the pilots of the future: our single-engine planes type P2002JF and our multi-engine planes type P2006T.

P2002JF is a great training plane for many reasons. Among other things, it features:

- Fantastic visibility
- Very good maneuverability
- Great aerodynamic characteristics
- Fuel efficiency
- Clear and logical instrumentation
- Amazing take-off and landing performance

- P2006T is an impressive high-end airplane. The most important advantages are:
 - Very good aerodynamic characteristics
 - Cockpit with all the features one's heart desires
 - Amazing performance with a fantastic range
 - Short take-off and landing distances



OUR SIMULATORS

Most of the flying lessons take place in our airplanes, however, we also have state-of-the-art, hightech simulators for training specific procedures and for targeting the education at the large and heavy airplanes.

Tecnam P2006T-simulator:

- Qualifies you before you train in real airplanes, 100% identical to real planes
- Gives you basic understanding of airplanes and procedures
- Allows experimentation with airplane limitations

FNPT II MCC-simulator:

- Realistic simulation of an A320 airplane
- Emphasis on jet and inertia management
- Preparation for the life in an airliner cockpit
- Focus on multi-crew cooperation
